Web Services motion

Since the PR Chair is vacant, and we have a significant issue to report, I am preparing a report direct to the ASC

On September 21st, at around 7 PM, an unauthorized person operating from Koln, Germany gained access to our web server. Initially, the individual deleted the media content (posters, service downloads, images, etc.) from the site. They then proceeded to delete the actual WordPress programs and configurations from the site. At this point (about 9 PM) I was notified that there was an issue with the site.

We promptly terminated the offender's access to the site, changed the 20-character random password he used to gain access, and restored the site from an offsite backup. There was no permanent loss of data, and normal functions were resumed by 1 AM.

We take as much care as we can to safeguard CTANA's asset. Access to the site is restricted to the three team members who maintain the site, and the Secretary, who maintains the email mailing list. Our accounts are protected by password complexity rules and 2-Factor Authentication using an app that changes the access token every minute, rather than just texting an access token. All site data is backed off site up weekly (more often if significant changes are made) and an email audit trail of updates to the site is maintained in real time.

We also run antivirus, access control, and failed login detection software. Our web site is also secured by SSL/TLS (https) security. We take additional steps which should not be publicly disclosed.

Unfortunately, there are gaps in our protection. In this case, the offender gained access through a rather insecure program called FTP which our web site provider, GoDaddy, requires us to have active even though we do not use it. We are also at risk for some forms of direct attack on the site through the web server itself. While we can take steps to secure these channels, our site is a small, non-commercial one. The risk was considered low. Obviously, that has changed.

To provide additional security, the Web Services team recommends that CTANA subscribe to an external firewall, which will allow us to disable the FTP channel used, provide better screening and antivirus protection, and allow us to restrict access to the actual site to users from North America and Mexico. It will also provide daily secure backups, and will give us access to GoDaddy's web security team who can respond to any future incidents without the need for CTANA to be dependent on volunteer resources. The cost for this service is approximately \$190/yr. A motion will be introduced this month to approve this expenditure.

We regret the incident which occurred last month, however we have attempted to use NA resources prudently by balancing cost against risk. The changing nature of on line threats suggests that a small additional expenditure is now appropriate.
