Greetings,

Thank you for allowing me to serve and represent you conscience at the region. Just a short report this month.

I was able to attend the **Tejas Bluebonnet Regional Assembly** onMarch 13<sup>th</sup>. There was a good turn out and CTANA was represented by a handful of GSRs.

- The Elections of the RD and RDA were held and as expected Steve P was elected RD. Our own Ruben P was elected RDA.
- Workshops were not held but rather we were directed to a WSC webinar on "How do virtual meetings connect to the service system?" It was held later that afternoon and I was unable to attend. Though I hear it was the same webinar that was held in November.
- We did have discussion of suggested topics for the WSC
  - 1. One of the suggested topics, Should Narcotics Anonymous World headquarters and/or WSC be relocated? We had a lot of good sharing. Most of the discussion was positive but there were few ideas on how to present such a topic without proper research. My understanding was that there was not enough financial incentive to make such a move. It is likely that this will be an agenda item, but to date, no useful study had shown that moving would profit us.
  - 2. There was also discussion about adding distribution centers for literature. We had a lot of talk about the subject, but it was clear that it was really in other countries were this is a viable idea. Countries were shipping is very expensive, could use their own distribution (printing) facilities.

Steve P. informed us about "A Month of Caring and Sharing – The Journey Continues" This is a thirty-day
event being held daily for the entire month of April to promote unity. Here is a quote from the website at:

Our mission is to increase individual direct financial contributions to NA and to develop a safe place for members to begin to have difficult conversations about shifting the self-support culture in Narcotics Anonymous. Questions like: How do we move from literature and product sales-based financial support to be member contribution focused? How do we encourage members to get involved in their local service bodies?
