Greetings,

Thank you for allowing me to serve and represent you conscience at the region. Just a short report this month.

I attended the Spring Regional Service Conference Saturday. May 8th 2021. As always, it was nice to see some of your faces there. Including some GSRs, thanks for participating.

I lost my notes so this is probably an incomplete snapshot. But here is what I remember.

The TBRCNA 2022 Convention committee changed the hotel Marriott courtyard. They had to move from the Omni after a huge price raise over the rescheduling for covid. They reported that they did not go through the three bid process and came to us to tell us so and ask for our acceptance of their actions. During the discussion, we found out that they really did get three bids, but rejected one for being outrageous. We accepted their decision and the convention will now be in Pflugerville with a good rate on rooms. I think the price is \$109

The CAC proposed flipping the rotation schedule for 2024 and 2025. Houston Area asked for the change and I honestly did not remember why, but the proposal passed and CBANA has already elected to accept the TBRCNA 2024.

I learned enough about how CBANA and other areas are obtaining nonprofit status without the expense we always hear about that I feel I should advise this area to look in to this as a possibility. The big advantage would be that we stop having so much trouble dealing with banks. But also our purchasing power would change, helping H&I and PR.

The Discussion session was about fostering more service participation.

Also, we did the virtual meeting survey together, but Groups are encouraged to do the survey

Steve P, your RD alternate brought forth two proposals for the CAR:

- Proposal # 1 To direct the World Board and NAWS to study creating a literature distribution / literature printing center in the Asian Pacific zone at the earliest possible moment.
- Proposal # 2 To direct NAWS and the World Board to study creating and opening an additional Literature distribution / literature printing center In the United States.

Though we did not have a lot of support for either of these, we did not have time to bring them back to you for a vote, before time to submit, so the proposal to submit these passed. I am including the proposals with my report. IMHO, this dialogue is most useful in keeping us aware that we should all be interested in the fellowships process of moving from Literature based income to self-funding by 7th tradition.
