**WHERE:** Beuscher State Park – LAKEVIEW Camping Area.

**WHEN:** Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024

**COST:** \$30 for both nights. *(Campsite's only).*

Tent or vehicle camping only. (No RV's or campers in Lakeview Area)

**NOTE:** LIMIT of 2 tents, 2 cars, and 8 people per site.

*There is plenty of overflow parking.*

**CAMPSITES:** #41-#60 each site has a picnic table, fire pit, and water hook up.  
Sites #56, #57, #58, #59, & #60 are walk-up sites *(no driving to or parking at site)*
