Hello all,

Our Policy Subcommittee met on March 27th. We are still in the process of combining, eliminating, and editing the current policy which has 31 sections.

Our goal is to be completed with the draft by July. We will probably have to meet twice a month to get this done, but the subcommittee is committed to do whatever it takes to get this accomplished.

We will then present the draft to all GSR's, ASC body and all Subcommittee Chairs for review.

Our intent is to have a "workshop" to have everyone's input and to finalize a new working CTANA policy. Details on how to proceed and what is to be expected we will present when the time comes.

We feel it imperative to get this done NLT fall 2022.

I had to make some hard copies of the current CTANA policy. I am submitting a receipt for the amount of \$25.49 for reimbursement.

CTANA Campout was a huge success. We had a total of 19 campsites each costing \$30 for the 2 nights.

The original invoice was \$690. \$570 for campsites and \$120 for the Pavilion.

I have collected \$540 (one no show) and have reimbursed CTANA for that amount. As in the past CTANA has always paid for the pavilion.
