RCM I Report Oct. 4th, 2020

Not much to report since last we met.

On Sept 26th 2020,

A full Treasury Audit of the TBRNA Bank Records was conducted. Tom K(TBRNA Facilitator), Michael S., Monica C., Chris C., and myself attended this Audit.

We reviewed and verified every transaction, verified NAWS and SZF donations to the decisions made at RSC's. Verified all reimbursement checks had corresponding request forms and receipts. We did find two 7th Tradition contributions on the website altho not reflected in the Bank account. Upon further inspection we found those two contributions sitting in our PayPal account. Thus we initiated a transfer of \$545.00 into the Bank account. To avoid this situation the web developer will add a "Payment Method" display to the tbrna.org 7th Tradition Register and create an email alert to the Treasurer. We had a check that has been outstanding since Aug 27th. We contacted the vendor and since they still have not received it as of Oct. 1st, we put a "Stop Payment" on that check and a Bill Pay check to them. After totaling and comparing the Bank Register we found a difference of \$15.00 to the positive. After double checking all entries back to Aug 2019 RSC we could not locate any error. To align the totals we added the \$15.00 "Correction" to the TBR Register.

He said "it's about recovery, not one program". I politely thanked him for his interest and explained that the addict specifically asked for an NA sponsor.

Teddy S will explain more during his report.
